

Infection Control Measures in Hostels under Pandemic

According to the latest pandemic situation and the regulation Cap.599 implemented by the Hong Kong Government, the following measures are required in the Postgraduate Halls in order to combat the spread of COVID-19 until further notice.

1. Residents **MUST** wear masks when leaving your room except while eating.
2. Visitors (including residents who are not residential students of that particular hostel) are not allowed. Visiting within the same hostel is not encouraged.
3. Group gathering of more than **4 persons** at public areas is **NOT** allowed.
4. Residents should keep a minimum distance of at least 6 feet from each other.
5. Residents should avoid dining or using pantry with others at the same time.
6. Dining in own room is highly recommended.
7. Non-residents who wish to apply “Overnight Visitor Ticket” will not be entertained.
8. Residents returned from outside Hong Kong are required to conduct body temperature measurement for 14 days consecutively and recorded in a form provided by PGH.
9. **IMPORTANT:** All student **MUST** only use the bathroom and kitchen of their own floor. This is extremely important for identifying close contacts should a confirmed case be detected.

Violations of the above-mentioned measures may result in disciplinary actions and penalty. Other than the measures above, the most important things we should do to avoid infection is to practice strict personal and environmental hygiene. Therefore, please be reminded to wash hands more often, avoid touching one’s face/nose/mouth, etc. It is because the virus is transmitted by droplets stick on surfaces.

In case of any respiratory symptoms developed, student must seek medical advice from [University Clinic \(UHS\)](#) promptly and wear a surgical mask. Please also inform the office at once when feeling sick or having a fever. Seek help from Security Office at 3943 7999 if counter staff is away in case of emergency.
