

Updated Quarantine and Self-monitoring Arrangement by University

Referring to the latest update by the government and the announcement from University dated 5 May, please find the latest quarantine and self-monitoring arrangement with immediate effect below:

Categories	Compulsory Quarantine	7-day Self-monitoring
Return2hk Scheme / Come2hk Scheme	--	On-campus
Visitors from Mainland and Macao NOT through Return2HK / Come2HK or from At-risk Places#	Off-campus	On-campus
Taiwan	Off-campus	On-campus
All places outside China	Off-campus	On-campus

Upon completion of off-campus compulsory quarantine, concerned students may return to their room to have 7-day self-monitoring. They are required to conduct testing mandated by the Department of Health and conduct rapid antigen testing daily during day 8 to 11 and report the results to PGH General Office.

Current residents are also reminded to submit the [Notification of Absence/Return](#) in advance before you temporarily leave and return to PGH. Otherwise, your access to PGH may be affected.
