## **General Rules**

- Participants' core responsibility is to write letters to their partners in the activity period.
- Each participant will be paired up randomly with another participant and become the angel of each other in the activity period. The participant can indicate the gender preference of their partner, but the assignment will be subject to enrollment situation.
- All participants must create nicknames for themselves such that the real identities would not be disclosed in the activity period. Animal is the designated theme of nicknames this time. Participants are recommended to create a special nickname to avoid duplications (e.g. Naughty Monkey in the Zoo, Red Rabbit in Suit).
- Successfully registered participants will be informed of his/her partner's nickname by email by 11 February. Participants are advised to write the first letter in English since the nationality of the partners would not be revealed.
- Participants can attach little gifts for their partners. However, the gifts shall not be expensive or precious items, and the size of them shall not be bigger than the slit of a letterbox.
- Though no secret angel reveal session will be arranged, participants are encouraged to keep contact with their partners after the activity period.
- PGH office reserves the rights for final decision of the activity.

## **Reminders on the Letters**

- Participants should make sure the nickname of the recipient is written clearly and correctly on the letter so that it can be delivered (E.g.: *To: Naughty Monkey in the Zoo*).
- Participants should prepare their own materials for writing, such as papers.
- The letter content shall not include any intimidating, harassment, law-breaking, or other inappropriate messages.

## Letter Collection and Delivery Schedule

- Participants should drop the letter to the activity letterbox located at the counter of JCPGH1, JCPGH3 or PGH4 by 9 am, Tuesday.
- The letters will be delivered to the participants' own letterbox by 11:59 pm, Thursday.
- PGH office is not responsible for the loss, misdelivery, or untimely delivery of the letters or gifts.
