# **Security and Safety**

#### **Keep Your Room Dry and Ventilated**

- Open windows, except during rainy days
- Use dehumidifier in spring and summer to avoid molds growing

 Use fan or air-conditioner to improve ventilation





#### **Remove Molds on Walls**

Molds are HARMFUL to Your Health • respiratory

issues skin allergy



Molds can be removed easily when addressed in the early cycle of growth.

Steps:
1. Open the windows
2. Wear a mask and gloves
3. Use diluted bleach (mix 1 part bleach with 10 parts water OR use vinegar only)
4. Spray on mold and wait 30 minutes
5. Wipe with a cloth and let it dry

If the situation is serious, please report it via **Repairing Logbook** at the counter.

#### **Clean Air-con Filter Regularly**

For better hygiene and air quality, wash the dust filter regularly when the A/C is frequently used

#### Wash Curtains & Mattress Cover

#### •They are machine washable.

• Dry them using a dryer on **LOW HEAT**, as high heat may cause damage.



## **No Adhesive Tape / Hook**

 Using adhesive tape / hook will damage walls and furniture

 Removable tape / hook is acceptable

#### **Electrical Safety**

Use only electrical appliances with 3-pin plug
Use only locally-purchased, branded and compliant appliances

## **Use of Microwave Oven**

#### MICROWAVE OVEN SAFE



Use microwave-safe containers only

Do not use metal containers and utensils





Always keep an eye on your food

• Clean up after use



### **Tips for Using Laundry Room**

- Empty all pockets before laundering
  Follow the steps of using the machines

- In case a machine is not working, stop using the machine and contact the staff for assistance
